

**Taylor Avenue Resurfacing
Open House

Purpose:

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to gather information from the neighborhood to suggest design parameters for resurfacing Taylor Ave. Inter-Mountain will summarize the comments and report to the to the Town Council for final direction.

Notes from Town September 18, 2024 Council meeting:

Design requests:

- Do not straighten roadway – repave in current location.
- Road section:
 - No curbs or sidewalks
 - Asphalt no wider than existing – narrower preferred for speed control.
 - Prefer speed dips (not humps) for traffic calming.

Parking:

- Trailhead – 54 spaces proposed.
 - Concern that it may be too much parking.
 - Concern about Minturn North residents use for guest/overflow parking.
 - Gravel parking on the east side of roadway should remain.

Drainage:

- Concerns regarding specific drainage crossings – need to identify locations.

Other:

- Would like to see overhead electric buried as part of the project.

Driveway paving:

- Several residents inquired about having driveways paved as a part of the project.
- Roadway beyond 569 Taylor is private and not part of Taylor Ave. Paving would be a private improvement.
