Dear Ms. Metteer,

Thank you for your continued commitment and cooperation in connecting Minturn to the Eagle Valley Trail system. As you know, we were unable to finish the last 600 feet of the project as we were unable to get an easement from UPRR prior to the end of construction season last year.

With the easement now secure, we are ready to help finish this last segment. We understand Ewing is already working on portions of the Eagle Valley Trail in the Minturn North Development, and has submitted a proposal for completing this critical last 600 feet for \$140,755. We also recognize previous contributions from the Town of Minturn for the Eagle Valley Trail project.

As such, Eagle County is committing \$150,000 from the ECO Trails fund towards the construction of the Eagle Valley Trail for the last 600 feet connecting to the Minturn North project.
