AGENDA ITEM: Approval of First Amendment to Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between the City of Mission and McAllen Public Utility – Terrazas

NATURE OF REQUEST:

The City of Mission and the McAllen Public Utility entered into an Interlocal Agreement on or about the 12th day of April, 2022 to undertake roadway widening improvements on Taylor Rd. between US. Business 83 and Interstate 2. (U.S. 83).

PUB and Mission now desire to extend the scope of the project to include the area of Taylor road between US Business 83 and Mile 2 Road (Daffodil Avenue) to include the installation of Water and Wastewater lines by Mission as an additive alternative in its request for bids for the expanded scope of the project.

PUB agrees that they will pay any and all costs to construct the Water and Wastewater Lines as per the expanded scope of the Project including, but not limited to, costs for materials, labor, and equipment in the amount of \$1,176,287.64. PUB will pay this amount on or before execution of an awarded contract.

PUB and Mission are authorized to enter into this Agreement pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Tex. Gov't Code 791.001 et. seq., which authorizes local governments to contract with each other to perform governmental functions and services under the terms of the Act.
