**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF MISSION, TEXAS,
ESTABLISHING AN ORDINANCE REVIEW COMMITTEE,
APPOINTING MEMBERS, ASSIGNING DUTIES AND PROVIDING FOR
AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND A DATE OF TERMINATION OF
ACTIVITIES.**

WHEREAS, City Council desires to create an Ordinance Review Committee to review the City's Code of Ordinances regarding possible revisions, determine which articles and sections of the Ordinances need amendment, deletion, or addition, develop a list of possible amendments to the City's Code of Ordinances for review by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council shall each select one responsible and independent member as their appointment to serve on the committee; and

WHEREAS, each Committee member shall serve until recommendations have been presented to the City Council for their review and approval; and

WHEREAS, each member of the committee shall serve without compensation; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and one Councilmember, on a rotating basis, shall also participate and attend Ordinance Review Committee Meetings; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, all Assistant City Managers, the Planning Director and the City Attorney, are hereby directed to support the Ordinance Review Committee and attend all meetings.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The following individuals are appointed to serve terms to the Ordinance Review Committee:

Section 2. The Ordinance Review Committee is charged with considering and making recommendations to the City Council, including but not limited to technical and other updated amendments that might be suggested by the Mayor, Council, Committee Members and/or City staff.

Section 3. The Ordinance Review Committee shall meet at least once per month and shall periodically submit final recommendations to the City Council by submitting the report to the City Secretary's Office to be placed on a City Council Agenda for Council's review, consideration, and action, if any is required.

Section 4. The City Council may amend the charge of the Ordinance Review Committee at any time.

Section 5. The Ordinance Review Committee shall serve at the pleasure of the City Council and shall serve unless or until replaced by the City Council and shall be subject to rules applicable to other City boards and committees.

Section 6. The Ordinance Review Committee shall cease to exist upon the accomplishment of the purpose for which it was created unless earlier abolished by majority vote of the City Council.

Section 7. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated as findings of fact and made part of this resolution for all purposes.
