**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS,
ADOPTING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM GUIDELINES AND
CRITERIA GOVERNING AGREEMENTS AUTHORIZED UNDER CHAPTER 380 OF
THE TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.**

WHEREAS, Chapter 380 of the Texas Local Government Code authorizes municipalities to establish and provide economic development programs, including grants, loans, and other incentives, to promote state or local economic development and to stimulate business and commercial activity within the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mission, Texas, finds that the adoption of Economic Development Program Guidelines and Criteria will promote economic development, encourage investment, create employment opportunities, expand the tax base, and further the public purposes authorized by state law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to adopt Economic Development Program Guidelines and Criteria to govern the consideration, negotiation, and approval of future agreements authorized under Chapter 380 of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has conducted a public hearing regarding the adoption of such guidelines and criteria and provided an opportunity for members of the public to be heard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The Economic Development Program Guidelines and Criteria attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"** are hereby adopted and shall govern all future agreements and incentives authorized under Chapter 380 of the Texas Local Government Code and considered by the City of Mission.

SECTION 2. The City Council may amend, revise, or repeal the Economic Development Program Guidelines and Criteria at any time as permitted by law.

SECTION 3. Adoption of these Guidelines and Criteria does not obligate the City to enter into any Chapter 380 agreement or provide any economic development incentive. Each proposed agreement shall be considered on a case-by-case basis and shall require approval by the City Council.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
