**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS,
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5693 TO ESTABLISH A STARLIGHT TOURNAMENT
FEE AT THE SHARY MUNICIPAL GOLF COURSE; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF
CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 5693 establishing rates and fees for the Shary Municipal Golf Course; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary and appropriate to establish a Starlight Tournament Fee while continuing to provide support for nonprofit organizations conducting charitable fundraising events;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

Ordinance No. 5693 is hereby amended to add the following fee to the Shary Municipal Golf Course Fee Schedule for Starlight:

Description	Fee
Starlight Tournament Fee (9 Holes with Cart)	\$55.00 per person

Each organization recognized as exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code shall be eligible to utilize the regular posted Starlight fee for one (1) tournament per calendar year. Any additional tournaments utilizing the Starlight lighting system conducted by the same organization during the same calendar year shall be subject to the regular Starlight Tournament Fee established herein.

SECTION 2.

All provisions of Ordinance No. 5693 not expressly amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4.

Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this Ordinance be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval according to law.
