

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 5035, KNOWN AS THE MISSION HISTORICAL PRESERVATION COMMISSION ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL RELATED PROVISIONS INCLUDING THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OVERLAY DISTRICT AND ASSOCIATED REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Mission, Texas previously adopted Ordinance No. 5035 establishing the Mission Historical Preservation Commission, Historic Preservation Overlay District, and related regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the best interest of the public health, safety, and welfare to repeal Ordinance No. 5035 and all provisions associated therewith; and

WHEREAS, the City Council retains authority under Chapter 211 of the Texas Local Government Code to regulate zoning and land use within the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. REPEAL

Ordinance No. 5035, entitled “Mission Historical Preservation Commission Ordinance,” including all provisions creating the Historic Preservation Overlay District, Historic Preservation Commission, Historic Preservation Officer duties, design criteria, designation processes, maintenance standards, certificate of appropriateness procedures, and any amendments thereto, is hereby repealed in its entirety and shall be of no further force and effect.

SECTION 2. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING PROVISIONS

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and publication as required by law.
