In compliance with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) rules and regulations, the City of Mission hereby announces that the DRAFT of the Five-Year Consolidated Plan and Strategy FY 2023-2027 and the Proposed Annual Action Plan 2023-2024 (40th) and are available for public review and comment. Further, there will be two public hearings held regarding the budget and proposed projects for the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) as recommended by the Citizens Advisory Committee. All interested agencies and citizens/residents are encouraged to attend and participate in the public hearings. This public hearing is part of the CDBG program Citizen Participation Process and complies with program requirements. The thirty-day comment period for this document is from June 2, 2023 through July 3, 2023. Oral and/or written comments will be accepted until 5:00 p.m. on Monday, July 3, 2023.

DRAFT Consolidated Plan and Strategy (CPS) Program Goals

The required goals of the CPS address the priorities of the funding provided by CDBG Program are to provide decent housing; a suitable living environment; expand economic opportunities; and to form and strength partnership.

Proposed Annual Action Plan (AAP)

AAP is a major component of the CPS. It sets forth the plan for activities for use of CDBG funds during the period beginning October 1, 2023 and ending September 30, 2024.
