

Proclamation

City of Mission



WHEREAS, in the year 1926, a small but faithful group of believers gathered in a house located at 210 Saint Marie St and later moved to gather at the corner of 5th and Saint Marie Street in Mission, Texas, where they planted the seeds of what would become a pillar of faith and spiritual life in the community, and

WHEREAS, in 1928, the congregation — guided by unwavering conviction and sacrificial dedication — constructed its first official church building at 420 Keralum Avenue in Mission, Texas, establishing a permanent place of worship and service for the community, and

WHEREAS, in 1932, the church was formally affiliated with El Concilio del Distrito Latino Americano of the Assemblies of God, aligning itself with a broader movement of faith committed to the proclamation of the Gospel and the advancement of the Kingdom of God throughout the Latin American community, and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 1983, construction began on a new and expanded house of worship at 1020 N. Los Ebanos Road in Mission, Texas, a testament to the continued growth of the congregation, and this building was completed and dedicated in 1986 to the glory of God, and

WHEREAS, in 2008, the congregation completed the construction of a third and more expansive building at the same address of 1020 N. Los Ebanos Road, providing a greater capacity to minister to, serve, and equip a growing body of believers across generations, and

WHEREAS, over the course of one hundred years, El Divino Redentor has faithfully proclaimed the Gospel of Jesus Christ, disciplined countless men, women, and children, served the Mission community with compassion, and stood as a beacon of hope, healing, and transformation; therefore, be it

NOW THEREFORE, we the City Council of the City of Mission, do hereby congratulate El Divino Redentor on their
