A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BY THE MISSION POLICE DEPARTMENT OF AN AGREEMENT FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATE RIGHT OF WAY OF THE SOUTHBOUND LANE (RIGHT LANE) OF FM 396 (BRYAN ROAD) FROM 8TH STREET TO 1ST STREET, SOUTH ON FM 107 (RIGHT LANE) FROM 1ST STREET TO BUSINESS 83, AND BUSINESS 83 (RIGHT LANE) TO HIGHLAND PARK DRIVE FOR THE SPEEDY 5K EVENT AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A PUBLIC PERMIT THEREFORE;

WHEREAS, the state owns and operates a system of highways for public use and benefit including Mission, in Hidalgo County; and

WHEREAS, the City has requested the temporary closure of the southbound lane (right lane) of Bryan Road from 8th Street to 1st Street, northbound lane (right lane) on FM 107 from 1st Street to Business 83, and Business 83 from FM107 to Highland Park Drive between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 3rd, 2023.

WHEREAS, the event will be located within the City's incorporated area; and

WHEREAS, the State, in recognition of the public purpose of the event, wishes to cooperate with the City so long as the safety and convenience of the traveling public is ensured and that the closure of the State's right-of-way will be performed within the State's requirement, and in connection therewith, the State requires an agreement between the City and the State in regard thereto; and

WHEREAS, 43 TAC, Section 22.12 establishes the rules and procedures for the temporary closure of a segment of the State Highway System; and

WHEREAS, the attached agreement has been developed in accordance with the rules and procedures of 43 TAC, Section 22.12.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The Speedy 5k is an event that serves a public purpose.

SECTION 2: The attached agreement which is made a part hereof for all purposes is approved and the City Manager is authorized to sign same on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3: Pursuant to said agreement, the City will close the southbound lane of travel (right lane) of Bryan Road between 8th Street to 1st Street, north on Conway Avenue (right lane) from 1st Street to Business 83, and Business 83 eastbound lane from Conway Avenue to Highland Park Drive.

SECTION 4: The City Manager is authorized to issue a parade permit for the Speedy 5k run.
