

**RESOLUTION # 1829**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION EXTENDING DISASTER DECLARATION ISSUED ON APRIL 29, 2023 REGARDING SEVERE WEATHER IMPACTING THE CITY OF MISSION ON APRIL 29, 2023**

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2023 the Mayor of the City of Mission determined that extraordinary measures needed to be taken to protect its citizenry from severe weather impacting the City of Mission and as authorized under TGC 418.00 issued a declaration of disaster for the City of Mission to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when the City of Mission is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the City Council is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Mission did proclaim the existence of a local emergency within said city on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2023 to expire on May 6, 2023.

WHEREAS, as authorized under TGC 418.108 (b) declaration of local disaster may be renewed, continue and remain in effect unless modified or terminated earlier; and

WHEREAS, this declaration activates the response, recovery and rehabilitation aspects of all applicable local or interjurisdictional emergency management plans and authorizes the furnishing of all aid and assistance as deemed necessary or desirable by those administering such plans, and activates the preparedness and response aspects of such plans as provided therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that said local emergency shall be deemed to be renewed and continue to have full force and effect as authorized by law for 90 days unless modified or terminated in the manner prescribed by law.
