Brief Summary:

Project Timeline

- <u>February 19, 2025</u> Application for Conditional Use Permit ("CUP") submitted to the City. (ATTACHMENT I)
- <u>March 6, 2025</u> In accordance with State and local law, notice of required public hearings mailed to all property owners within 200 feet of subject tract.
- <u>March 19, 2025</u> Public hearing and consideration of requested Conditional Use Permit by the Planning and Zoning Commission (P&Z).
- <u>March 24, 2025</u> Public hearing and consideration of requested conditional use permit by the City Commission.

<u>Summary</u>

- The site is located along the East side of N. Conway Avenue approximately 75 feet North of E. Tom Landry Street.
- Pursuant to Section 1.43(3)(F) of the City of Mission Code of Ordinances, an Event Center requires the approval of a conditional use permit by the City Council.
- The building was built is 1973 for an office space, credit loan, martial arts and fitness gym.
- The applicant is leasing a building for an Event Center and Bakery.
- Proposed activities: A children's event center and bakery.
- The proposed hours of operation are as follows: Monday Sunday from 10:00am to 9:00pm
- Staff: 3 employees
- Parking: Due to the 60 proposed chairs, a total of 20 parking spaces are required. Because this property is located within the Mission's Central Business District, exempt from parking requirements for the existing structure.
- The Planning Staff has not received any objections to the request from surrounding property owners. Staff mailed out (24) legal notices to surrounding property owners.
- In accordance with the zoning ordinance, the P&Z and City Council may impose requirements and conditions of approval as are needed to ensure that a use requested by a conditional user permit is compatible and complementary to


adjacent properties. (ATTACHMENTS IV-VI)

Staff recommends approval of the request subject to compliance with the following conditions:


- 1. Life of use with the understanding that the permit can be revoked

- 5. Compliance with noise ordinance




