SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE INTERIM ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT ("Amendment") to the Agreement for Interim Administrative Services ("Agreement") by and between the City of Mission, Texas hereinafter called "City and/or Interim Administrator" and Mission Redevelopment Authority (MRA)/Mission Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone Number One, hereinafter called "TIRZ" for interim administrative services related to the TIRZ. The TIRZ and Interim Administrator, in consideration of the mutual promises and conditions herein contained, agree as follows.

WHEREAS, the City and TIRZ entered into an agreement effective on January 1, 2023 for interim administrative services related to the TIRZ; and

WHEREAS, the City and TIRZ now desire to amend the Agreement as described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained in this Agreement, and for good and valuable consideration, the TIRZ and the City agree as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Second Amendment by reference as findings of fact as if expressly set forth and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The Agreement, Article III, is hereby amended to read as follows:

TERM OF CONTRACT

The term of this Agreement shall commence on the effective date and shall terminate on March 31, 2024 unless otherwise extended by written agreement, executed by both parties.

Section 3. As amended and supplemented, hereby, the Agreement is ratified and shall remain in full force and effect. The term "Agreement" shall mean the agreement effective on January 1, 2023, for interim administrative services (including all exhibits and attachments as originally agreed upon) as amended and supplemented by this Second Amendment. In the event of a conflict between this Second Amendment and the Agreement, this Second Amendment shall control.
