A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BY THE MISSION POLICE DEPARTMENT OF AN AGREEMENT FOR THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATE RIGHT OF WAY OF THE NORTHBOUND LANE (RIGHT LANE) OF FM 494 (SHARY ROAD) FROM VICTORIA STREET TO FM 495 (GRIFFEN PARKWAY), WEST ON FM 495 (RIGHT LANE) TO FM 396 (BRYAN ROAD), SOUTHBOUND ON FM 396 (RIGHT LANE) TO U.S. BUSINESS HIGHWAY 83, WEST ON U.S. BUSINESS HIGHWAY 83 (RIGHT LANE) TO TEXAS HIGHWAY 107 (CONWAY AVE.), NORTHBOUND ON TEXAS HIGHWAY 107 (RIGHT LANE) TO MILE 2 ROAD, EAST ON MILE 2 ROAD (RIGHT LANE) TO FM 494 (SHARY ROAD) AND SOUTHBOUND ON FM 494 (RIGHT LANE) ENDING AT 200 NORTH SHARY ROAD FOR THE CHICK-FIL-A HALF MARATHON EVENT AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A PUBLIC PERMIT THEREFORE;

WHEREAS, the state owns and operates a system of highways for public use and benefit including Mission, in Hidalgo County; and

WHEREAS, the City has requested the temporary closure of the northbound lane (right lane) of Shary Road to East Griffin Parkway, west on Griffin Parkway (right lane) to Bryan Road, south on Bryan Road, (right lane) to U.S. Business Highway 83, west on U.S. Business Highway 83 (right lane) to Texas Highway 107 (Conway Avenue), north Texas Highway 107 (right lane) to Mile 2 Road, east on Mile 2 Road to Shary Road and south on FM 494 (Shary Road) to 200 N. Shary Road between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, February 18, 2023.

WHEREAS, the event will be located within the City's incorporated area; and

WHEREAS, the State, in recognition of the public purpose of the event, wishes to cooperate with the City so long as the safety and convenience of the traveling public is ensured and that the closure of the State's right-of-way will be performed within the State's requirement, and in connection therewith, the State requires an agreement between the City and the State in regard thereto; and

WHEREAS, 43 TAC, Section 22.12 establishes the rules and procedures for the temporary closure of a segment of the State Highway System; and

WHEREAS, the attached agreement has been developed in accordance with the rules and procedures of 43 TAC, Section 22.12.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The Chick-fil-A is an event that serves a public purpose.

SECTION 2: The attached agreement which is made a part hereof for all purposes is approved and the City Manager is authorized to sign same on behalf of the City.

SECTION 3: Pursuant to said agreement, the City will close the northbound lane of travel (right lane) of Shary Road between Victoria Drive to East Griffin Parkway, west on Griffin Parkway (right lane) to Bryan Road, south on Bryan Road (right lane) to U.S. Business Highway 83, west on U.S. Business Highway 83 (right lane) to Texas Highway 107, north on Texas Highway 107 (right lane) to Mile 2 Road, east on Mile 2 Road (right lane) to Shary Road, south on Shary Road (right lane) to 200 North Shary Road.

SECTION 4: The City Manager is authorized to issue a parade permit for the Chick-fil-A half marathon run.
