**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS,
AUTHORIZING TO LIQUIDATE SURPLUS CITY-OWNED REAL PROPERTY BY
SOLICITING AND RECEIVING OFFERS FOR ITS SALE PURSUANT TO TEXAS
LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE CHAPTER 272; AND PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, the City of Mission, Texas owns certain real property that has been determined to be surplus to the City's current and future municipal needs; and

WHEREAS, Texas Local Government Code Chapter 272 authorizes a municipality to sell municipal real property in accordance with statutory requirements, including public notice and competitive bidding or proposals, unless an exception applies; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to entertain offers for the sale of the following City-owned properties:

1. **Lot 2, Block 2, Tolle #2 R/S LT 22-1 U/R Tolle Subdivision #2 (Adam Street)**
2. **Carlos G. Leal Subdivision, Lot 19, Block 6 (919 Rankin)**
3. **Mission Palms Estates East, Lot 144 (1733 Dalobo Drive)**
4. **Nell Tolle Subdivision, Lot 14 (1400 West Ray Circle)**

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that entertaining offers for the sale of these properties is in the best interest of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes City staff to entertain offers for the sale of the City-owned real properties described above in compliance with Texas Local Government Code Chapter 272, City policies, and all applicable laws.

SECTION 2. City staff is authorized to take all necessary actions to solicit, receive, and evaluate offers, including providing any required public notice.

SECTION 3. Any sale of the properties shall be subject to final approval by the City Council through separate Council action.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
