GRANTING A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT A DRIVE-THRU SERVICE
WINDOW AT 722 E. 8TH STREET, LOTS 11 & 12 & 20' STRIP ADJ. TO LOTS, BLOCK 113,
MISSION ORIGINAL TOWNSITE**
