Why is the City of Millwood's housing allocation (0.14% or up to 106 units) almost 3 times the population allocation (0.05% or 49 persons)?

The 2020 and 2046 data is utilized and projected reduced average household size is factored (2.44 vs. 2.28)

1,874 population in 2020 / 2.44 average household size = approx. 768 occupied housing units

1,974 population in 2046 / 2.28 average household size = approx. 865 occupied housing units

865 minus 768 = 97 additional occupied units (106 total allocated units)

Number of households equals the number of occupied housing units.

The number of housing units divided by the average household size does not directly equal population increase. This calculation provides an estimate of the total population, but it's a simplified model and doesn't account for various factors that contribute to population growth, such as births, deaths, and migration.

106 units / 2.28 = 46.49 estimated population increase (Millwood is allocated a 49 person increase for 2046)

The HAPT Spreadsheet figures are calculated for all of Spokane County with numbers rounded
