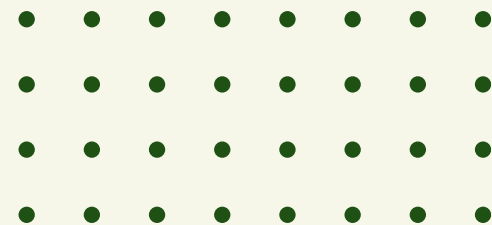
OUR MISSION

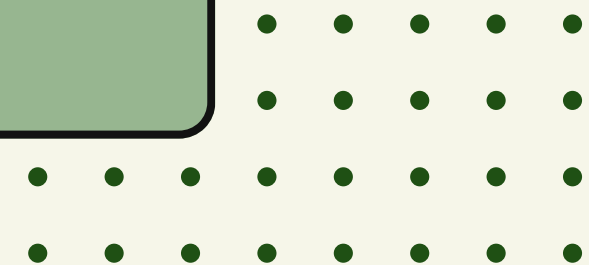
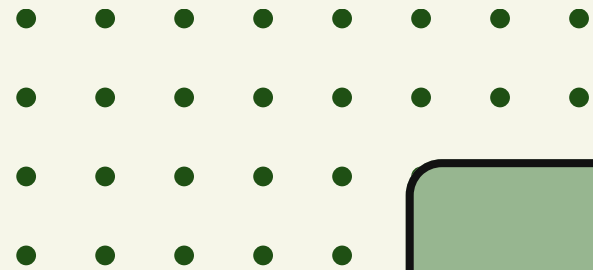


OUR VOLUNTEERS

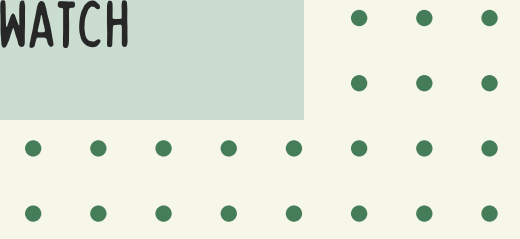
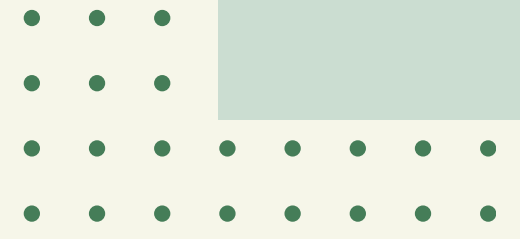

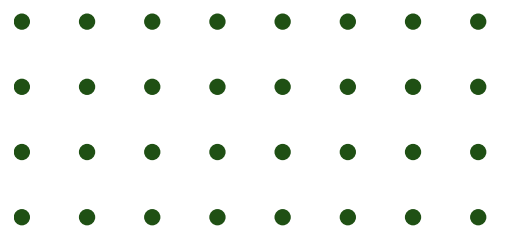
SCOPE INCIDENT RESPONSE TEAM

SCOPE INCIDENT RESPONSE TEAM

- SUPPORTING THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN CONTROLLING TRAFFIC AT DIVERSE INCIDENTS, CRIME SCENES & COMMUNITY EVENTS. ONGOING TRAINING REQUIRED.
- THESE VOLUNTEERS ARE ON CALL/STANDBY DURING THEIR 24 HOURS SHIFT. THEY ARE READY TO GO WITHIN 15 MINUTES OF BEING DISPATCHED AT ANY TIME & AT ANY HOUR.
- SO FAR THIS YEAR, THROUGH APRIL WE HAVE A TOTAL OF 174 ON SCENE HOURS TOTAL 2851 HOURS IN SIRT
- TOTAL STANDBY HOURS TO DATE ARE 2447, THIS IS WHERE THE VOLUNTEER IS ON CALL FOR PERIOD OF TIME AND MAYBE DISPATCHED AT ANYTIME.



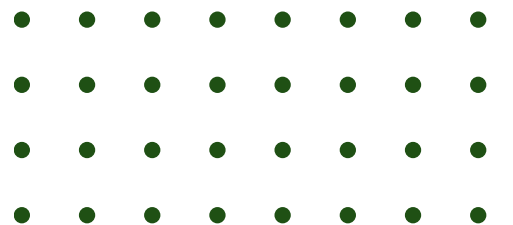

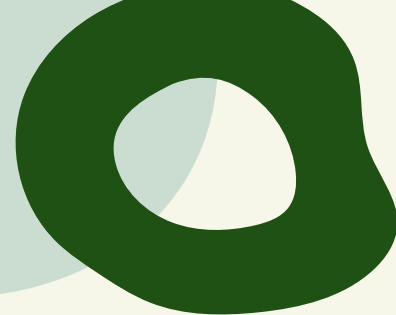
- ACTING AS EXTRA EYES & EARS FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT BY PATROLLING NEIGHBORHOODS, SCHOOLS, TRAILS & MORE IN ORDER TO REDUCE CRIME. ALSO PROVIDE PROWL CHECKS FOR BUSINESSES & HOMEOWNERS.
- SCHOOL PATROL ~ MONITORING THE SAFETY OF CHILDREN ARRIVING & LEAVING LOCAL SCHOOLS.
- CENTENNIAL TRAIL PATROL ~ WORKING WITH STATE & LOCAL PARK SERVICE TO PATROL THE TRAIL & TRAIL HEADS.
- YEAR TO DATE: 1500 HOURS.



ADDITIONAL PROGRAMS

- BIKE SAFETY/HELMET FITTING: WORKING WITH LOCAL SCHOOLS & COMMUNITIES TO TEACH CHILDREN BICYCLE SAFETY & PROPER HELMET FITTING.
- BUSINESS RELATIONS: BUILDING RELATIONSHIPS W/ LOCAL BUSINESSES, CONDUCTING PROWL CHECKS & MORE.
- COMMUNITY SERVICE: ASSISTING COMMUNITIES BY PROVIDING INFO, RESOURCES & SERVICES FOR SPECIAL EVENTS.
- DISABLED PARKING PATROL: COMMISSIONED VOLUNTEERS EDUCATE THE PUBLIC & WHEN NECESSARY, ISSUE CITATIONS FOR VEHICLES ILLEGALLY PARKED IN PARKING SPACES DESIGNATED FOR THE DISABLED.
- ERC (EMERGENCY RADIO COMMUNICATION): ASSIST RESIDENTS WITH EMERGENCY NEEDS & COMMUNICATE VIA RADIO TO EMERGENCY RESPONSE DISPATCHERS DURING WIDESPREAD POWER OUTAGES & DISASTERS.
- OFID (OPERATION FAMILY ID): PHOTOGRAPH & FINGERPRINT CHILDREN & VULNERABLE ADULTS FOR FAMILIES TO HAVE IN AN EMERGENCY.
- RADAR WATCH: A RADAR READER BOARD OR TRAILER IS USED TO DOCUMENT SPEEDING IN PROBLEM AREAS.
- SHERIFF'S FRONT DESK/SPECIAL PROJECTS: ANSWER PHONES, TAKE REPORTS, HANDLE COMPLAINTS, RESPOND TO PUBLIC INQUIRES AT THE PUBLIC SAFETY BLDG & TAKE ON SPECIAL REQUESTS FOR THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE.
- TRAFFIC CONTROL/FLAGGING: CONTROL TRAFFIC AT MANY FUNCTIONS LIKE PARADES, FUN RUNS, ETC.

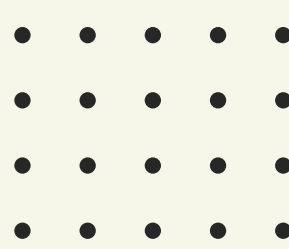
