RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCE NO. 501 BY TITLE AND SUMMARY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the city council of the city of Minnetrista that the city clerk shall cause the following summary of Ordinance No. 501 to be published in the official newspaper in lieu of the entire ordinance:

Public Notice

The city council of the city of Minnetrista has adopted Ordinance No. 501, an ordinance amending the official zoning map of the city of Minnetrista. The ordinance rezones property located near the intersection of Co. Rd. 110 West and Halstead Avenue (formerly the site of a manufactured home park) from R-2 Low-Medium Density Single Family Residence District (R-2) to Planned Unit Development (PUD). The rezoning will be effective upon adoption and publication of the ordinance and recording of the final plat of North Pointe at Halsted Bay. The full text of Ordinance No. 501 is available for inspection at Minnetrista city hall during regular business hours.
