<u>Issue:</u> City Council recently authorized staff to solicit quotes to replace and expand the security camera and access control system for the City of Minnetrista. Below is a summary of that solicitation, and the results of the quote solicitation.

<u>Overview:</u> The current security camera system and access control system have reached the end of life and need to be updated. Below is a summary of the locations and equipment needed. The funding source for this project will be an equipment certificate paired with a future bond sale, split amongst the appropriate funds based on location of the improvements.

## **Sunnyfield Tower (1 Exterior Camera)**

- Exterior Camera pointing at entrance
  - o Full installation requiring switch

### **PW Building (2 Exterior Cameras)**

- Exterior Camera pointing at Gas Pumps
  - o Full installation requiring switch
- Exterior Camera pointing at Yard
  - o Full installation requiring switch

# Well No. 03 (1 Exterior Camera, 1 Key Card Access)

- Exterior Camera pointing at entrance
  - o Full installation requiring switch
- Bluetooth key card access at main entry door
  - o Full installation requiring hardware, conduit, wire, and switch

### North Water Treatment Plant (2 Exterior Cameras, 3 Key Card Access)

- Exterior Camera pointing at west entry point
  - o Full installation requiring switch
- Exterior Camera pointing at east entry point
  - o Full installation requiring switch
- Bluetooth key card access at Well #3
  - o Replacement of existing
- Bluetooth key card access at main plant entrance
  - o Replacement of existing
- Bluetooth key card access at chlorine door

  - o Replacement of existing
- Bluetooth key card access at chlorine door
  - o Replacement of existing

# Southwest Water Tower (1 Exterior Camera, 2 Key Card Access)

- Exterior Camera pointing at gate
  - o Full installation requiring switch
- Bluetooth key card access at main entry door
  - o Conduit and boxes installed, require switch and wire
- Bluetooth key card access to interior control room
  - o Conduit and boxes installed, require switch and wire

### Police Building (3 Exterior Cameras, 24 Interior Cameras, 34 Key Card Access)

- Replace all existing cameras (Add one new)
  - o 3 Exterior Cameras
    - One new exterior camera
  - o 24 Interior Cameras
- Replace all existing key card access (Bluetooth)
  - o 34 existing

### City Hall (2 Exterior Cameras, 9 Interior Cameras, 11 Key Card Access)

- Replace all existing cameras (Add one new)
  - o 3 Exterior Cameras
    - One new exterior camera
  - 9 Interior Cameras
- Replace all existing key card access (Bluetooth)
  - o 11 Key Card Access

**Quote Summary:** Below is a summary of the quotes received; those quote documents are also attached to this agenda item:

Security 101 - \$157,736.12 USA Security - \$153,312.00 Grove Security - \$148,390.83 Loffler - \$137,399.73

After reviewing the quotes, three of the vendors are proposing comparable products and software to the Brivo/EagleEye system that were presented to City Council. Staff have reviewed the substituted items and have determined they are adequate in specifications.
