## Subject

Consideration and possible action on a request from the Montgomery First Baptist Church for relief from Chapter 90 Utilities, Section 90-68(a) which governs the cost of the City's public water system tap.

## Recommendation

No action thereby letting the regulations stand

## **Discussion**

Montgomery First Baptist Church added square footage to their existing building which kicked in the fire suppression requirements. I assume a new tap is needed for the increased capacity for the fire suppression. The church is required to obtain a "water tap" from the city to connect the new line(s) to the public water system. Section 90-68(a) of our adopted regulations states:

## Sec. 90-68. - Commercial water and sewer tap charges.

- (a) If a tap or connection is made for the commercial, *institutional*, or industrial consumer to the city's water distribution system, the charge to be made for such tap shall be the sum of:
- (1) The actual costs and expenses incurred by the city of providing the service (including labor and materials); and
  - (2) Two hundred percent of said actual costs and expenses.

The church has formally requested the Council provide financial relief by waiving the fee in part or entirely. I do not see any variance options or any language in our Ordinance providing for appeal or relief so I will defer to the City Attorney for the process, if there is one, in which the Council can waive this requirement.
