
Photo # 1 is an illustration of current mural; noting the 8 feet space (open area) on the right and the left side of the mural itself

Right side, Photo # 4, is a depiction of Samual McCulloch; the first Texian casualty of the Texas revolution. This is similar to the sculpture seen locally at Simmons bank sculpted by local Artist Craig Campobella. This art design would be about 3' x 3' in size. Note that both murals would be small enough so as not to overwhelm the central mural. Local Artist Joe Kolh. Tx and Beyond will be covering the cost.
