## **RESOLUTION NO. 2025 - XX**

A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON AN APPLICATION BY WEEKLEY HOMES FOR A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO PLACE A TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION TRAILER ON A RESIDENTIAL LOT LOCATED AT 703 GUNNER COURT IN THE REDBIRD MEADOWS DEVELOPMENT (KNOWN AS BRIARLEY).

- **Section 4: THAT** notice of the public hearing shall be published one time, in a newspaper of general circulation in the City, at least fifteen days prior to the date of the hearing stating the time and place of the hearing.
