What is A Crime Control & Prevention District (Origination)

- ► The Crime Control and Prevention District (CCPD) is authorized by Section 363 of the Texas Local Government Code and is created and renewed by a vote approximately every 5 years
- ► A Crime Control and Prevention District is a special purpose district created for the purpose of improving crime prevention and reducing crime.
- In 1989, the Texas Legislature recognized that smaller cities within large metropolitan areas are greatly impacted by "big city" crime without the "big city" resources to fight the crime problems they face.
- ► The Legislature passed the Crime Control and Prevention District Act to enable cities to create a special district that can collect a sales tax specifically dedicated to crime control and reduction.



Facts about (CCPD) Crime Control & Prevention District

- ► A CCPD supports crime control and prevention programs, public safety operational expenses and related capital purchases. The proposed District (CCPD) would collect 1/4 cent sales tax on sales within the City of Montgomery. These monies would be utilized to fund things such as:
- ► Fund proposed police and court facility to address the growth for future needs.
- Police officers
- Recruitment and training of police officers
- Equipment, technology, vehicle replacement
- Crime prevention and partner programs



Number one question about (CCPD): Does it increase taxes?

No. The sales tax rate would not increase $\frac{1}{4}$ of the proposed tax dollars for the CCPD would come from the type B development Corporation (MEDC)

With the creation of the CCPD would allow for monetary relief to the City's General Fund with savings estimated at \$1 millon. Allowing the General Fund to be reallocate its resources to the needs such as streets, parks, and recreation and other quality of life projects.
