Discussion

Chapter 363 of the Local Government Code allows for a governing body to establish a Crime Control and Prevention District, which allocates ¼ of a cent of Sales Tax revenues to Crime Control and Prevention programs that support the Police Department. This allocation will allow for monetary relief to the Annual Budget and will provide other resources, such as streets, parks, and quality of life projects, with more funding.

The city is growing rapidly and a Crime Control and Prevention District will allow the police department to provide quality assistance to the community. This District will fund things such as officer salaries, new police and court facility, training, equipment and technology updates and replacements, etc.
