Discussion

This item was originally heard at the September 28, 2021, City Council meeting and was deferred until this meeting to allow for more time for names to come forward.

Each jurisdiction entitled to vote in the election of the Montgomery County Appraisal District's Board of Directors may nominate a candidate for each of the five positions to be filled.
