Major Incidents

• On March 13, 2023, Officers Clark and Hensley attempted to pull over a vehicle matching the description of a stolen vehicle that dispatch advised was heading toward the City of Montgomery. The vehicle accelerated in an attempt to flee and both officers pursued the vehicle. The pursuit ended up in Walker County, where the suspect exited the vehicle and fled on foot. Officer Hensley deployed a drone to try to locate the subject but was unable to locate him at that time. Multiple agencies assisted during and after the pursuit, including the use of K9s. The suspect was ultimately arrested on March 16th.
