A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CEC
FOR THE GENERATOR CONTRACT

WHEREAS, the City of Mount Pleasant wishes to enter into an *Agreement Between Owner and Engineer for Professional Services with Civil & Environmental Consultants, Inc.* (CEC) to provide engineering services associated with a new emergency generator sized to provide power to the Water Treatment Plant to operate critical facilities during a power outage event; and,

WHEREAS, Engineering Services will include: Design, Bidding support, and Engineering During Construction Support; and,

WHEREAS, the project has received funding from USDA Rural Development in the form of a WEP Disaster Grant; and,

WHEREAS, the *Agreement Between Owner and Engineer for Professional Services with Civil & Environmental Consultants, Inc.*, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is in good order and is in the best interest of the City of Mount Pleasant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF MOUNT PLEASANT, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Mount Pleasant Board of Commissioners approves the *Agreement Between Owner and Engineer for Professional Services with Civil & Environmental Consultants, Inc.* to provide engineering services associated with a new emergency generator sized to provide power to the Water Treatment Plant to operate critical facilities during a power outage event on the terms set forth on Exhibit A and authorizes and directs the Mayor to sign the same.

Section 2. If any one or more of the provisions of this Resolution, or any exhibit or attachment thereof, shall be held invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, by final decree of any court of lawful jurisdiction, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision hereof, or of any exhibit or attachment thereto, but this Resolution, and the exhibits and attachments thereof, shall be construed the same as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein, or therein, as the case may be.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
