
Contract

The Senior Americans Multipurpose Center, 205 Farror Street, Moberly, Missouri, will provide 940 meals, the actual cost being \$13.54 to the elderly in Moberly for \$4,000.00 for our projected year July 1st, 2025 through June 30th 2026.

In addition to the above, 15,000 units of social service or more, one hour constituting a unit of service, will be provided at no charge for the project year.

With this contract the elderly will be provided health and welfare services which is the goal of the Senior Americans Multipurpose Center.

One hot nutritious meal will be provided to the homebound elderly in order to help maintain them in their own home. The mobile elderly will receive a hot nutritious meal at our local nutrition site, and a program of social activities will also be available to add to their well being.
