- Agenda Item: An Ordinance Approving A Depot Park Path Improvements Reimbursement Agreement With The Downtown Moberly Community Improvement District.
 - **Summary:** McCormick the City's contracted sidewalk contractor is planning to pour stamped concrete to replace the brick path at the south end of Depot Park. The path would continue from the current stamped concrete path that ends just north of the museum and wrap around the concrete pillars under the new awning, tying into the stamped concrete path will run to the south side of the museum. The stamped concrete path will run to the caboose and tie into the City sidewalk near the pedestrian bridge, creating an inviting walkable loop in Depot Park.

Following the project will then update site feature placement, turf, and trees following the project to enhance the park at a relatively low cost. This is a project that will really enhance Depot Park and make it more inviting. As history shows, the more inviting we make a property and the more positive activity we attract, the more it drives out less desirable traffic.

The CID contribution (capped at \$10,000) would help offset the cost of the project which is estimated to be just over \$31,000.
