A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF TWO PARK BENCHES IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH SIDES OF COATES STREET TO COMMEMORATE THE IMPORTANCE OF THE RAILROAD TO THE CITIZENS OF MOBERLY, MISSOURI.

WHEREAS, the city, the state and Norfolk Southern Railway Company (“Norfolk”) recently completed the installation of a new railroad crossing at Coates Street in downtown Moberly and the employees of Norfolk desire to commemorate the importance of the railroad to the citizens of Moberly by installing two park benches in the city right-of-way near the crossing; and

WHEREAS, the city may permit the installation of facilities in its right-of-way as provided by the city code; and

WHEREAS, city staff requests that the Council permit the installation of two park benches by Norfolk employees and grant Norfolk a license for the limited purpose of installing and maintaining two park benches within the city right of way on the north and south sides of the Coates Street railroad crossing.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Moberly hereby grants Norfolk employees a limited license for the purpose of installing two park benches within the city right of way on the north and south sides of the Coates Street railroad crossing and further authorize the City Manager to take any necessary action to accomplish the purpose of this Resolution.
