**A RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATIONS FOR THE HENNEPIN COUNTY
YOUTH ACTIVITIES GRANTS PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Maple Plain is committed to providing safe, accessible, and inclusive recreational opportunities for youth within the community; and

WHEREAS, Hennepin County administers the Youth Activities Grants Program to support youth recreation, athletic facilities, playgrounds, and play spaces for residents throughout Hennepin County; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified several park and recreation improvement projects that will enhance recreational opportunities, accessibility, safety, and long-term community use for youth and families; and

WHEREAS, the proposed projects include:

1. Replacement of the outdoor hockey rink at Rainbow Park;
2. Playground Pour-in-Place Surfacing Replacement Project at Veterans Memorial Park; and
3. Playground Pour-in-Place Surfacing Replacement Project at the Oak Street Tot Lot; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that these projects support the goals of the Hennepin County Youth Activities Grants Program by improving recreational facilities and play areas serving youth ages 18 and younger; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to authorize submission of grant applications for these projects through the Hennepin County Supplier Portal in accordance with program requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Maple Plain, Minnesota, as follows:

1. The City Council hereby approves the submission of applications to the Hennepin County Youth Activities Grants Program for the following projects:
 - a. Rainbow Park Hockey Rink Replacement Project;
 - b. Veterans Memorial Park Playground Pour-in-Place Surfacing Replacement Project; and
 - c. Oak Street Tot Lot Playground Pour-in-Place Surfacing Replacement Project.

2. The City Administrator, or their designee, is authorized to prepare, execute, and submit all grant application materials and supporting documentation necessary for consideration under the Hennepin County Youth Activities Grants Program.
3. If awarded, the City agrees to comply with all grant program requirements, reporting obligations, and grant agreement conditions established by Hennepin County.
