Public Hearing – Consideration to approve a resolution giving preliminary approval for the issuance of the City’s General Obligation Street Reconstruction Plan Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$625,000; and adopting the City of Maple Plain Minnesota Street Reconstruction Plan in connection with financing the 2026 Sidewalk and Budd Avenue Removal and Mill/Overlay at Spring, Marsh, and Industrial Street Reconstruction Project. The project goal is to provide long-term safety, capacity, and preservation improvements to accommodate the needs of the City of Maple Plain.

MAY 18: OPEN PUBLIC HEARING

The City Council is requested to hold a public hearing and approve a resolution for the issuance of Street Reconstruction Plan Bonds and adopt the Street Reconstruction Plan in connection with those streets. The City has caused notice of the public hearing on the intention to issue the Bonds and on the proposed adoption of the Plan by resolution adopted April 27.

The public hearing notice appeared in the local official newspaper on May 2 no more than 28 days and no less than 10 days prior to the public hearing, for compliance with Minnesota Statutes.

Attached you will find the Street Reconstruction Plan as prepared by Ehlers & Associates for the construction of various bituminous mill/overlay projects as described in the Plan by the issuance of Street Reconstruction Plan Bonds. You will note the Plan contains the project description and required findings of the Council.

CLOSE PUBLIC HEARING

MAY 26: RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION

After closing the public hearing, the Council will consider the following alternative actions relating to the preliminary approval of the Bonds and adoption of the Plan. The resolution must be approved by at least two-thirds of the members present.

Alternative Action:

1. A motion to approve the resolution.
2. A motion to approve the resolution at a lesser amount.
3. A motion to deny approval of the resolution.
4. A motion to table any action.
