Summary:

The Council to consider an update to parking regulations to improve safety, efficiency, and year-round operations. The proposed approach would standardize mailbox placement by requiring mailboxes to be located on one side of the street, while maintaining a no-parking restriction on that same side.

These parking regulation changes create a clear and consistent corridor for mail delivery and public safety services. By consolidating mailboxes to one side, postal vehicles can operate more efficiently without crossing traffic, and public safety operations can be completed more safely and effectively. Maintaining no parking on the mailbox side of the street would help prevent obstructions, reduce conflicts between parked vehicles and service providers, and improve overall traffic flow.

This discussion is intended to gather Council input on feasibility, community impact, and implementation considerations. The policy aims to balance operational efficiency with resident convenience while supporting safe and reliable service delivery throughout the community.
