### Summary

Staff is seeking funding through the Minnesota Department of Transportation's 2025 Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) to support its Downtown Redevelopment Project. This initiative includes the reconstruction of E Main Street, Maple Avenue, Pioneer Avenue, and the fire station parking lot. The project aims to improve deteriorating pavement conditions, enhance pedestrian connectivity, support fire station access, and stimulate economic development in the city's central business district.

Staff needs the City Council to formally authorized staff to prepare and submit an LRIP funding application, requesting up to \$1.5 million. As Maple Plain is not a State Aid city, the resolution also seeks sponsorship from Hennepin County to meet program requirements. The City commits to funding ineligible project elements and adhering to LRIP guidelines, with construction anticipated in 2026.
