## Summary

On June 2, 2026, the Fire Relief Association General Membership and Board of Trustees each convened to consider the proposed transfer of the SVF account back to the Fire Relief Association. Following discussion, a formal vote of the firefighter membership was conducted and the measure was approved by a majority vote.

The Board of Trustees subsequently considered the same action and adopted a formal resolution authorizing the transfer, which was likewise approved by a majority vote.

Pursuant to statutory requirements, the City Council must also take action on this matter by June 20, 2026. Approval by the Council is necessary to complete the transfer process.

### **Recommended Action:**

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the resolution approving the transfer of the SVF account back to the Fire Relief Association.
