RESOLUTION NO. 2026-0427-01

**APPROVING THE GATEWAY PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK
SIGN QUOTES FOR PURCHASE**

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2026, the Assistant City Engineer presented recommendations to improve pedestrian safety along Gateway Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the City Council directed staff to obtain quotes for in-crosswalk pedestrian signage and solar-powered flashing pedestrian signs; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2026, City Council Workshop, the City Administrator presented quotes received from EFA Division of Safety Signs for the requested signage; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approves the transfer of funds from the capital improvement fund to the general fund for the expense of purchasing the pedestrian signs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council directed staff to present a resolution for approval of the submitted quotes, which include the following:

- Solar Powered Flashing Pedestrian Sign: \$3,425.00
- In-Crosswalk Two-Sided Pedestrian Signs with Bases: \$705.50

WHEREAS, the total cost for the purchase of pedestrian safety signage is **\$4,130.50**; and

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements are intended to enhance pedestrian visibility and safety along Gateway Boulevard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Maple Plain, Minnesota, as follows:

1. The City Council hereby approves the purchase of pedestrian crosswalk signage from EFA Division of Safety Signs in the total amount of **\$4,130.50**.
2. The City Administrator may execute all necessary documents and take proper actions to complete the purchase and install the pedestrian signs.
3. Funding for this purchase shall be distributed from the capital improvement fund to the general fund for the expense of purchasing the pedestrian signs.
