

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-0427-05

A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN FUEL STORAGE TANKS AS SURPLUS PROPERTY AND AUTHORIZING THEIR SALE

WHEREAS, the City owns certain fuel storage equipment formerly used by the Public Works Department and Fire Department in support of municipal operations; and

WHEREAS, said equipment includes one or more above-ground fuel storage tanks and related components that are no longer required for City purposes due to operational changes, replacement, or redundancy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the continued ownership and maintenance of this equipment is no longer in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes § 471.345 authorizes municipalities to sell surplus personal property by public sale or auction when such property is no longer needed for public use;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Maple Plain Minnesota, as follows:

1. Declaration of Surplus Property

The following fuel storage equipment is hereby declared surplus to the needs of the City:

- Two (2) approximately 900-gallon above-ground fuel storage tank, skid-mounted, with electric fuel transfer pump, hose, and nozzle
- Associated fuel dispensing components and accessories
- Fuel type: gasoline and diesel

2. Authorization to Sell

City staff are hereby authorized and directed to sell the surplus fuel storage equipment through an online public auction platform, including but not limited to GovDeals, in an as-is, where-is condition, with no warranties expressed or implied.

3. Disposition of Proceeds

Proceeds from the sale of the surplus equipment shall be deposited into the appropriate City fund in accordance with City policy and applicable law.

4. Administrative Authority

The City Administrator, is authorized to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution, including execution of any required sale or transfer documents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
