A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF THE 2025 METROPOLITAN COUNCIL ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES INFLOW AND INFILTRATION GRANT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Plain is served by the Metropolitan Council Environmental Services (MCES) sanitary sewer system; and

WHEREAS, MCES offers Inflow and Infiltration (I/I) grant funding on a biannual basis to reimburse cities for eligible construction activities that reduce sanitary sewer inflow and infiltration; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified eligible expenses associated with multiple projects, including the Downtown Reconstruction Project, Industrial Street Improvements, and sanitary sewer cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) improvements; and

WHEREAS, eligible grant activities must occur between January 1, 2026, and December 31, 2027, with final documentation and agreements due by March 2028; and

WHEREAS, City staff time required for application submittal and grant tracking is minimal and will be charged to the respective projects; and

WHEREAS, the City's consulting engineer, Bolton & Menk, Inc., has requested authorization to submit the MCES I/I grant application on behalf of the City by January 30, 2026

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Maple Plain, Minnesota, that:

1. The City Council hereby authorizes the submittal of the 2025 MCES Inflow and Infiltration Grant Application for eligible sanitary sewer improvement projects.
2. The City Administrator and consulting engineer are authorized to prepare, submit, and administer the grant application and related documentation on behalf of the City.
3. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
