RESOLUTION 2025-06 ~ APPROVING GOVERNING BODY RESOLUTION FOR AUTHORIZED AGENTS FOR THE STATE & LOCAL CYBERSECURITY GRANT PROGRAM

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Adopt Resolution 2025-06 authorizing the following positions within Mission Springs Water District to apply for federal disaster assistance on behalf of the District: General Manager, Assistant General Manager, Director of Finance, Director of Operations.

SUMMARY

In September 2024, MSWD applied for a subrecipient grant through CalOES to improve the District's cybersecurity posture. MSWD was selected as a subrecipient and awarded \$246,150 in grant funding with no match requirement. The grant requires the board to pass a new Governing Body Resolution.

ANALYSIS

CalOES requires that the governing body of applicant organizations pass a resolution designating which positions within the organization are authorized to apply for disaster assistance aid on its behalf. This resolution ensures that only specified individuals can represent the District in the application process, streamlining the process and maintaining accountability. By clearly defining these roles, the District can effectively manage cybersecurity funding requests and ensure that applications are submitted by individuals with the proper authority.
