EMS REPORT **December 2025**

Mayor Patterson, North Baltimore EMS responded to 75 calls for service in December 2025, with a total of 776 runs on the year.

Calls consisted of:

- Cardiac/Stroke 7
- Motor Vehicle Accidents 10
- Falls/Lift Assists 6
- Fire/Medical Alarms 4
- Breathing issues 12
- Overdose 1
- Abdominal Pain 4
- DOA 3
- Seizures 2
- Psychiatric Issues 5
- Other Medical Emergencies - 21

Of these calls for service 63 calls were in the Village, 10 out in Henry Twp. 1 calls onto I-75, 1 in Bloom Twp. (Mutual Aid) and 0 in Jackson Twp. (Mutual Aid) Our 2nd squad was out on 4 calls this month handling back-to-back calls.

Year 2025 Totals

Of these calls for service 634 calls were in the Village, 90 out in Henry Twp. 28 calls onto I-75, 19 in Bloom Twp. (Mutual Aid) and 8 in Jackson Twp. And 3 (Mutual Aid) in other Wood County agencies.

Call requests: 30 came in between the hours of 7pm and 7am, 45 came in between the hours of 7am and 7pm. 29 calls for service on the South side of the tracks and 44 on the North side of the tracks.

Average response time from EMS receiving the call, to EMT's arriving at the Pt. was 7.03 minutes for the month.

All squads are back in service at this time. New used squad from South East 150 has been purchased. Awaiting new 2026 budget to set up and put in service.
