ORDINANCE NO. 2026 - 13

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS AND TRANSFERS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2026, FOR THE SR 18 MULTI-USE PATH AND POE ROAD SIDEWALK PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of North Baltimore was awarded \$688,000 in Carbon Reduction Program funding through the Toledo Metropolitan Area Council of Governments (TMACOG), now known as Lake Erie West Regional Council, for the SR 18 Multi-Use Path and Poe Road Sidewalk Project, PID 124989; and

WHEREAS, Council previously authorized the professional engineering services agreement with Kleinfelder, Inc. for the project through Resolution No. 15-2026, adopted as an emergency measure; and

WHEREAS, supplemental appropriations and transfers are necessary to fund the professional engineering services agreement with Kleinfelder, Inc. and related project costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of North Baltimore, Wood County, Ohio:

SECTION 1. The following transfer and supplemental appropriation are hereby approved for fiscal year 2026:

TRANSFER FROM: Fund 2405-620-396-0000 (Sewer Tap Assessment) \$101,600.00

TRANSFER TO: Fund 2903-620-346-0000 (Sidewalk Special Assessment) \$101,600.00

APPROPRIATED TO: Fund 2903-620-346-0000 (Sidewalk Special Assessment) \$101,600.00

SECTION 2. The Fiscal Officer is authorized to make the necessary entries and certifications required by law.

SECTION 3. Council finds that this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Village. Immediate appropriation and transfer of funds are required to permit execution of the professional engineering services agreement authorized by Resolution No. 15-2026 and to advance the SR 18 Multi-Use Path and Poe Road Sidewalk Project. Delay in appropriating and transferring the necessary funds may jeopardize project scheduling, federal funding eligibility, coordination with the Ohio Department of Transportation and Lake Erie West Regional Council, and the Village's ability to meet required project development milestones. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption.
