RECOMMENDED ACTION: Presentation on the NBU Fiscal Year 2023 Strategic Plan Results

BACKGROUND

During the June 2022 New Braunfels Utilities (NBU) Board of Trustees meeting, the FY 2023 strategic plan was officially approved with the budget approval process, establishing a comprehensive framework for our strategic goals and annual priorities to ensure continued operational excellence.

The fiscal year 2023 marked the inception of a new strategic plan anchored by six strategic goals and their corresponding performance metrics. Additionally, we introduced 17 annual priorities with performance objectives to channel our efforts toward mission-critical areas.

Throughout the year, while navigating resource constraints, NBU remained steadfast in its commitment to achieving the strategic goals and addressing the essential annual priorities central to our mission. Furthermore, we responded proactively to emergent initiatives as they arose during the year.
