RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approve the NBU Mutual Aid Policy

BACKGROUND

This Mutual Aid Policy (“Policy”) formalizes the current procedure and governs the provision of mutual aid pursuant to Chapter 418 of the Texas Government Code and any other applicable law, and the ability to enter into interlocal agreements for emergency assistance pursuant to Section 791.027 of the Texas Government Code. This Policy is intended to provide broad authority to the Chief Executive Officer, or the designee thereof, to provide or decline to provide mutual aid to a local government entity requesting aid from New Braunfels Utilities (“NBU”) in the event of a disaster or other emergency and to enter into written agreements on behalf of NBU to provide mutual aid.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no direct financial impact associated with adoption of the Mutual Aid Policy. The Policy authorizes the CEO to pursue reimbursement for eligible costs incurred when providing mutual aid to requesting entities.
