<b>Background:</b> On June 28, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2022-52, establishing a formal policy for naming City-owned land, buildings, and facilities (attached). At the April 8, 2025 City Council meeting, a recommendation was made to name the location that consists of Ed Parry Field and Phillips Field to the "Needles Little League Baseball Complex." Ed Parry Field and Phillips Field will remain. What is being considered is the naming of the complex.				
Ed Parry Field is located on River Street & adjacent to the Railroad Tracks. Ed Parry was employed in the Recreation Department and was responsible for bringing Sports to our Youth in Needles.				
Phillips Field is adjacent to Ed Parry Field. John Phillips, of Phillips Construction, has been in the community since 1963 and his company is responsible for many city and school construction projects.
