Metal Theft

AB 1941 (Gonzalez, M) Organized metal theft.

This measure would enhance enforcement against copper wire theft by targeting repeat and organized offenders who steal, or traffic prohibited metal materials, and would establish a statewide data-sharing tool to allow for increased visibility into organized theft operations.

Cal Cities Position: Support/Co-Sponsor

Driving Under the Influence

AB 1546 (Schultz) Vehicles: driving under the influence

This measure would increase penalties for those with 2 previous DUI convictions to a wobbler and those with 4 or more with a felony.

Cal Cities Position: Support

AB 1662 (Wilson) Driving record: points: diversion

This measure provides that if a defendant has completed diversion from a DUI related charge the information must still be transmitted to the DMV to place on the individuals driving record.

Cal Cities Position: Support (Letter Pending)

Driving Under the Influence

AB 1874 (Wilson) Vehicles: Driver's License Suspension and Revocation.

This measure would require that the court's order of the revocation of a license begins when an individual is released from custody.

Cal Cities Position: Support (Letter Pending).

SB 907 (Archuleta) Driving under the influence: comprehensive reform.

This measure would make changes to the penalties for committing vehicular manslaughter.

Cal Cities Position: Support (Letter Pending).

Fire Insurance/Wildfires

AB 1559 (Calderon) Residential property insurance images.

This measure would require notice to homeowners of any aerial footage to be taken during the policy period for purposes of insurance.

Cal Cities Position: Support

AB 1934 (Bennett) State Fire Marshall: home hardening.

This measure would require the Office of the State Fire Marshall to develop a certification program for home hardening by January 1, 2028.

Cal Cities Position: Support (Letter Pending)

Fire Insurance/Wildfires

AB 1986 (Bennett) Home Hardening.

This measure would require an insurance company to provide specific details on discounts available if home hardening is completed and certified by the Office of the State Fire Marshall.

Cal Cities Position: Support (Letter Pending).

AB 2724 (Bauer-Kahan) Catastrophe Modeling.

This measure would change the definition of distressed counties for the purposes of the Catastrophe Modeling regulations.

Cal Cities Position: Support (Letter Pending).

Fire Insurance/Wildfires

SB 911 (Becker) Transfer of real property: high fire severity zones

This measure would require that when a property is being sold, the local fire agency must be provided notice regarding home hardening and if a no documentation is submitted within one year the local fire agency must conduct a compliance inspection.

Cal Cities Position: Pending.

Fire Insurance/Wildfires

SB 959 (Grayson) Average Daily Attendance: emergencies

This measure would allow a fire chief to declare an evacuation in the case of an emergency.

Cal Cities Position: Support (Letter Pending)

SB 1270 (Richardson) Wildfire Mitigation Program: assistance to counties

This measure would expand the Wildfire Mitigation program to the top 10 most distressed counties.

Cal Cities Position: Pending

Loitering for Prostitution

AB 2582 (Schultz) Crimes: prostitution.

This measure would provide diversion for those who have been arrested multiple times for loitering for prostitution.

Cal Cities Position: Pending.

AB 2749 (Sharpe-Collins) Crimes: loitering.

This measure would provide that a person is guilty of the loitering for prostitution only if the person takes a direct but ineffectual act towards its commission and the act must go beyond planning or preparation.

Cal Cities Position: Pending.

Nitrous Oxide

SB 758 (Umberg) Public health: nitrous oxide.

This measure would prohibit the sale of nitrous oxide at retailers with a tobacco license except for grocery stores.

Cal Cities Position: Co-Sponsor.

SB 936 (Blakespear) Nitrous Oxide: sales.

This measure would prohibit the sale of nitrous oxide and create new penalties for selling the product including revoking the business license.

Cal Cities Position: Support.

Nitrous Oxide

AB 2076 (Lowenthal) The Parent's Accountability and Child Protection Act: online marketplaces: nitrous oxide.

This measure would add nitrous oxide to the list of products that it is illegal to sell on-line unless age verification is provided by the buyer.

Cal Cities Position: Support (Letter pending).

SB 1314 (Menjivar) Smoke shops: locations, hours of operation and sale of nitrous oxide.

This measure would prohibit smoke shops from selling nitrous oxide and would prohibit the location of a smoke shop within 600 feet of a day care center.

Cal Cities Position: Track.

Public Safety - Miscellaneous

AB 1632 (Johnson) Trespass.

This measure would remove the notary requirement for a Trespass Letter of Authority and would extend the applicability of the request from 12 months to 3 years for properties with fire hazard, absent owners, or those closed to the public.

Cal Cities Position: Support.

AB 1959 (Patel) Juvenile justice.

This measure would prohibit the recall and resentencing conviction of a juvenile convicted of murder and other serious crimes.

Cal Cities Position: Pending.
