Background: The City has received a significant boost for its animal welfare efforts. The application submitted to California for All Animals in September 2023, seeking funding to implement a <u>Trap, Neuter, Release (TNR) Program</u> to manage the free-roaming cats in Needles, has been awarded a substantial amount of \$112,000.			
 The funding awarded will provide One new vehicle to transport animals to a veterinarian, One new part-time employee (1-year term), TNR program supplies (traps, trap covers, tarps, gloves, etc.), veterinary services (up to 200 animals), and public education. 			
The proposed TNR program will improve the areas where domestic and non-domestic cats are found, reduce diseases, and provide a better quality of life for the community cats. The goal is to eliminate euthanasia at our Animal Shelter by providing an alternative for captured free-roaming cats and increasing adoption rates of those able to be rehomed.			
The City's Animal Shelter has been operating without a TNR program due to various limitations, including vehicle, budget, and staffing constraints. However, with the grant award, the Animal Shelter is now equipped to launch its first-ever TNR program, which will serve as a pilot project for one year. The City Council accepted the award on January 9, 2024, and the funds have been received. The staff will use sole-source procurement contracts to obtain government pricing on the fleet, and the new unit from Anderson Ford in Bullhead City is ready for delivery.
