A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEEDLES, CALIFORNIA ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 FUNDED BY SB-1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS Senate Bill 1 (SB-1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS SB-1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of the City of Needles are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS the City of Needles must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB-1, which must include a description and the locations of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the projects' completion, and estimated useful life of the improvements; and

WHEREAS the City of Needles, will receive an estimated \$129,190 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2025-2026 from SB-1; and

WHEREAS the scope to include Grind and Pave 1-1/2 to 2" with Petromat on the Streets identified in the Phase 5A Street Improvements. Lillyhill Dr (*Parkway St – Coronado St*), Parkway Street (*Lillyhill Dr – Rio Vista St*) Peru Street (*El Monte St – Lillyhill Dr*), Peru Street (*Desoto St – Balboa St*), Cortez Street (*Desoto St – Balboa St*), Coronado (*Lillyhill Dr – Rio Vista*), Balboa Street (*Desoto St – Balboa St*), Coronado (*Lillyhill Dr – Rio Vista*), Balboa Street (*Desoto St – Balboa St*), Coronado (*Lillyhill Dr – Rio Vista*), Balboa Street (*Desoto St – Balboa St*), Flora Vista (Parkway – Balboa St), J Street (Parkway – Balboa St), Luna Vista (Parkway – Balboa St), J Street), Balboa Street (Rio Vista – J Street), and Sidewalk Safety Repair Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the City Council of the City of Needles, California as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct
- 2. The following proposed and previously proposed and adopted projects may utilize fiscal year 2025-2026 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their life's delivery. With the re-listing of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution. The City of Needles is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues.
 - a. Phase 5A Street Improvements; Lillyhill Dr (Parkway St Coronado St), Parkway Street (Lillyhill Dr Rio Vista St) Peru Street (El Monte St Lillyhill Dr) Peru Street (Desoto St Balboa St), Cortez Street (Desoto St Balboa St), Coronado (Lillyhill Dr Rio Vista) Balboa Street (Desoto St Rio Vista) Grind & Pave with Petromat. Starting 07/2025 and ending 06/2026 with a useful life of 20 years.
 - b. Phase 5B Street Improvements; Rio Vista (*Parkway Balboa St*), Luna Vista (*Parkway Balboa St*), Flora Vista (Parkway Balboa St), J Street (Parkway St I-40), Coronado St (Rio Vista J Street) Balboa Street (Rio Vista J Street). Grind & Pave with Petromat. Starting 07/2025 and ending 06/2026 with a useful life of 20 years.
 - c. The Sidewalk Safety Repairs Program consists of removal & replacement of existing broken, lifting or deteriorating sidewalks that are causing hazards and replace with new ADA compliant sidewalks. The locations are generally within the center of Needles proper and described as all streets from Columbus Dr / Needles Hwy South to San Clemente Street and Parkway Street East to the Colorado River. Street cover approx. 3.5 sq miles. Starting 07/2025 and ending 06/2026 with a useful life of 50 years.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of Needles hereby adopt Resolution No 2025-21, SB-1 the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 plan to include street improvements under the Phase 5A & 5B Improvement Plans of the Paving Management Plan and the repair of Public Sidewalks under the Sidewalk Safety Repair Program along with other funds.
