Background: In September 2016, Governor Brown signed into law SB 1383 which establishes targets to achieve a 75 percent reduction in the level of the statewide disposal of organic waste by 2025. Food recovery means collecting edible food that would otherwise go to waste and edistributing it to feed people in need. This is the highest and best use for food that would otherwise go o waste. Feeding hungry people through food recovery is the best use for surplus food and a vital way or California to conserve resources and reduce waste thrown in landfills. SB 1383 requires certain food ousinesses to donate the maximum amount of edible food they would otherwise dispose, to food ecovery organizations. While the City of Needles has an organic disposal program waiver, staff efforts have been on educating and supporting edible food recovery.				
The City of Needles has provided a local non-profit edible food recovery past for the past two years. The funding is from the Mojave Desert and Mountain Recycling Authority. Funds are to be used to support the local non-profits expenses associated with edible food recovery.
