On June 25, 2025, the CPUC issued a formal audit report identifying multiple findings and potential violations under various General Orders (GOs), including GO 95, GO 128, and GO 165. The City was required to respond by July 25, 2025, detailing corrective actions taken.			
City staff and management reviewed the CPUC audit findings and submitted a comprehensive response on July 25, 2025, detailing corrective actions and preventive measures. These include establishing auditable maintenance and inspection programs under GO 95 and GO 165, implementing vegetation management, patrol logs, and inspections of overhead and underground systems. Physical corrections included repainting corroded transformers, replacing missing high-voltage signage, repairing ground wires and molding, and addressing down guy wires and locking mechanisms. The response has been submitted to the CPUC and will be publicly posted in accordance with their transparency policy.			
Fiscal Impact: The total estimated cost to address the CPUC audit findings is \$10,000. This includes the replacement of two leaking pad-mounted transformers at \$3,900 each, repairs to signage, ground wiring, pole steps, and equipment corrosion, as well as associated staff time and materials. All expenses will be covered by the Electric Department's existing Operations and Maintenance budget.
